

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Delegations representing the Government of the Dominican Republic and the Government of the State of Israel (hereinafter the "Parties") met in Colombo, Sri Lanka on 5 December 2017 during ICAN 2017 event. A list of the members of the two delegations is attached in the Appendix.

The discussions were held in a cordial and friendly atmosphere and the Parties have reached the following understandings:

1. Air Services Agreement

Both Parties agreed to complete their respective internal procedures for the signature and entry into force of the Air Services Agreement between the Government of the Dominican Republic and the Government of the State of Israel initialed on 8 December, 2016 during ICAN 2016 event in Nassau, the Bahamas (hereinafter the "Agreement") as early as possible.

Pending its formal signature and entry into force, the Parties came to the understanding that they shall act in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement.

Such practice shall only commence on the date on which the Government of the State of Israel has notified the Government of the Dominican Republic of the completion of its internal procedure which authorizes it to act in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement.

For the avoidance of doubt, such application shall not be deemed a provisional application of the Air Services Agreement in accordance with the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties.

2. Entry into Force

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into effect on the date of its signature. Notwithstanding the above, the Capacity Entitlement in the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of the Dominican Republic and the Government of the State of Israel dated 8 December 2016 would come into effect on the date on which the Government of the State of Israel has notified the Government of the Dominican Republic of the completion of its internal procedure which authorizes it to act in accordance with the provisions of the Agreement.
