

Memorandum of Understanding

The Delegations representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the Government of the Dominican Republic of whose names appear in Appendix "1" met in Aqaba –Jordan 4/12/2019 to discuss matters relating to Air Services arrangements between the two countries, pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Aeronautical Authorities of the 7th of December 2017.

As a result of these discussions which were held in a very cordial and friendly atmosphere, the following understandings have been reached:

1- Air Services Agreement

- 1.1 Reference to the Dominican Republic ratification of the Chicago convention the Delegation of Jordan proposed to replace the current IASA with a new IASA including all amendments agreed by both Parties in MOU signed in the 7th of December 2017.
- 1.2 After discussions, the Heads of the two Delegations initialed the Air Services Agreement (referred to as ASA hereinafter) on this day stated below in the English language (Appendix 2).
- 1.3 The Delegations agreed to prepare their respective ASA versions in the Arabic, Spanish and English languages and to recommend to their respective Governments to sign the ASA at the earliest possible date. Place and date of the signing ceremony will be determined through diplomatic channels.
- 1.4 The Delegations, furthermore, decided that they would each act in conformity with the spirit of the IASA and the amendments until ASA entry into force.
- 1.5 Both Parties agreed to put all efforts to sign the ASA in ICAN 2020.

2- Designation

2.1 The Delegation of Jordan designated the following airlines to operate the agreed services on the specified routes:-

- Royal Jordanian Airline
- Jordan Aviation
- Any other Airlines shall be designated in writing.

2.2 The Delegation of the Dominican Republic designated the following airlines to operate the agreed services on the specified routes:-

- Airlines to be designated by the Aeronautical Authorities
